Safety Notice

The safety of our students and staff are very important to us at St. John Catholic School. We practice safety drills throughout the year to ensure students and staff are prepared and proper measures are in place in case of an emergency.

Our school will be working closely with School Officer McGowan to practice a lock down drill this week. We will have an assembly where he will review school procedures. We will then participate in a drill. We will be repeating the drill three more times over the next few weeks to reinforce the procedures.

The goal of any of these drills is to improve our response skills and to make our school a safe place to learn and work.

Registration Information

Registration packets were sent home with students on Tuesday, February 27th

Tuition for the 2018-2019 school year will be \$3600 for affiliated families and \$4600 for non-affiliated families. We assure you that the decisions regarding tuition are made with great care. We want to sustain a quality academic program and environment families have come to expect from our Catholic School.

Families who register on or before March 31st will have a reduced registration fee. The fees are as follows: First child \$75.00, Second child \$50.00, Third child \$25.00. This amount will be applied to tuition for K-8 students for the 2018-2019 school year.

A \$200.00 reduction in tuition will be given to anyone who refers a new family that results in a completed registration and enrollment for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year
